 - In general-we will focus on peers

- Current structure, and what to expect in the future
 - Clarification of Chairs, Seats and Members
 - Searching for 5 seats from each Mental Health and Substance use category
 - Representation within voting members is important
 - Looking for more people to apply for a seat on the Substance Abuse voting
 - *Question*: If I have co-occurring disorder. Which side do I apply to?
 - *Answer*: Apply for a seat on both mental health and substance use groups.

IV. Peer Support Partner Grandfathering Process (Melissa Penaflor)

- Peer Support Senate Bill 803
 - California passed a peer support certification program
 - Deadline for Peers to seek certification through the grandparenting process is June 30, 2023
 - *Requirements:* 18+ years old, high school diploma, work experience, 3 letters of recommendation
- CAMPHRO Update
 - PEP Training
 - Group study meetings to help with peer certification tests
 - Free for all peers
 - PEP Exam Preparation Peer Support Groups
 - Support groups help peers deal with potential test anxiety and other worries surrounding certification tests
 - Building Peer Leadership
 - A peer professional networking networking event held on Zoom every first and third thursday of the month
 - CalMHSA provides in person testing sites
- NAMI's New Resource
 - Medi-Cal Peer Support Specialist Training Program
 - Cost: Free
 - Location: Online
 - Date and time: starting March 13 for 2.5 weeks 12:30-4:30 PM
 - Requirements: 18+ years old, reside in San Diego or Imperial County, have a high school diploma, possess personal experience or care for someone with a mental health/substance use disorder
